

## Census tract Median Family Income as a percent of Area Median Family Income, as of 2023.

Census tract Median Family Income (MFI) as a percent of Metro Area MFI, as of 2023. According to Community Reinvestment Act (CRA) specifications, this percent is calculated by dividing 2016-2020 Census ACS tract MFI by the 2016-2020 Census ACS MSA/MD MFI. For tracts located outside of Census defined metro regions, the denominator is the statewide non-MSA/MD MFI. This figure includes incomes from all areas not assigned to MSA/MDs. Tracts with MFI less than 50% of MSA/MD MFI are classified as low-income tracts. Tracts with MFIs equal or greater than 50% and less than 80% are moderate-income tracts. Tracts with MFIs equal or greater than 80% and less than 120% are middle-income tracts. All the tracts with MFIs equal or greater than 120% are categorized as upper-income tracts. Areas with Insufficient Data are shown in grey on the map. For more information about CRA regulations, please see our Data Directory.
